

Eligibility:

1. Students must be enrolled full-time at A&M main campus (College Station, TX) for Fall'09
2. Minimum GPR (overall): 2.5/4.0
3. Nationality is NOT a barrier; both domestic and international students are welcome to apply
4. Students from all majors may apply

Guidelines on completing the form:

1. Essay: Brief summary of your understanding of the importance of US China relations. (Word limit: 1000)
2. Reasons for participation: Please describe your motivation for wanting to participate in the conference. You may mention how your participation will fulfill your career objectives. (Word limit: 200)
3. Student leadership experience: Enumerate (numbered/bulleted) your previous student leadership experiences in reverse date order (most recent first and least recent last). Please don't attach resumes. For each such vocation, please mention the size of the group you were involved with, goals to be achieved by the group, challenges faced by the group and then mention how you guided your group (allocated tasks among group members, encouraged individual members to be productive, did conflict resolutions) and drove it to success.

Format:

All documents should be typed in 12 point, Times New Roman Font, 1.5 line spacing and single column format.
